

2026 USG Soybean Sales Reporting

USG Grower Point of Sale Reporting (GPOS)

The forms have remained fairly the same (some minor changes) and the process has remained the same. The three forms can be emailed, faxed, or mailed to us. USG will need to know the Trait License number for every farmer who plants a single bag of Enlist, RR2Xtend or XtendFlex soybeans. **This is required in the office by August 3, 2026.**

You (the USG Licensee) will fill out the **Retail Sales form** for any sales you sold directly to the farmer. **Replants and parent seed included.**

You will forward the **Wholesale Reporting Form** to any Ag/Chem retailer you whole-saled USG soybeans to or you can submit the report on their behalf. (You are responsible to see that they report the sales).

The **USG Transfer Form** is for any USG seed you transferred between yourself and another USG Dealer Member.

PLEASE REPORT YOUR PARENT SEED.

Make a note on the side of that line or an asterisk with a note. (Example enclosed). It can be a sale to yourself.

The information required by Bayer is basically the same as what is required by Corteva. So to make things easier, you can use the same form for Enlist, Xtend, and XtendFlex reporting!

This will be due August 3, 2026.

Enlist Reporting



All growers are required to have a Corteva Technology Use Agreement (TUG) to purchase seed. The TUG must have a new Corteva license for 2020 and beyond. Available online at www.agcelerate.com

RR2Y/RR2Xtend/XtendFlex Genuity Reporting



All growers are required to sign a **NEW** Bayer Technology Stewardship Agreement (BTSA) 2024 or later to purchase seed. Let us know if you need any updated paper forms. The BTSA can also be renewed online www.agcelerate.com

Deadline for growers to sign an Enlist, RR2Y, RR2Xtend, and XtendFlex license is July 30th

We have paper MTSA and GTL forms available upon request

Conventional and Glyphosate Tolerant Soybean Reporting (USGT)

No agreement is required but we still need the grower information to accurately report the genetic broker fees for the breeder of each variety. Glyphosate tolerant soybean varieties still have genetic breeder patents on the seed.

XtendFlex™	\$31.00 per 140K seeds/unit
Enlist E3™	\$25.00 per 140K seeds/unit
USGT	\$ 7.00 per 140K seeds/unit
Conventional	\$ 5.00 per 50lb. Bag or 140K unit

Submitting your GPOS in a timely fashion is a large part of your USG rebates eligibility. If you need help with your GPOS info please contact the office.

USG Replants

Replants are due by **August 1st** and the form is available the last week of May. It is also included in this GPOS packet and is on the dealer log in page on the USG Website. If you need it re-sent or a paper copy mailed to you please contact the office. You have to send in the original sale invoice and the replant invoice to qualify.

USG Discarded Soybeans

Please send in your seed discard log records (Enclosed) for any USG Seed that was **hailed off during harvest, dumped after cleaning , not sold and dumped, or any cleanings dumped.** Please label each weight ticket with the USG variety(ies) included on that truck and how many bushels or units were dumped. This **is required by both Corteva and Bayer.**

USG Soybean Seed Conditioning reports

If you haven't sent in a USG Seed Sampling report for each lot you conditioned (Or an in house conditioning report) please do so now. They are due at the same time as your GPOS reporting, **August 3rd**. If you need a new USG Seed Sampling Book please let us know and we will ship you one.

Seed Samples

If you sent your own sample to the lab and did not send a conditioned sample to USG, please send in a 2 POUND samples for each lot of USG Soybeans you conditioned. These are **required** by Corteva and Bayer for USG to keep on hand for 2 years. This is in addition to any samples you keep at your location.

All the GPOS, Replant, and Discard forms have been emailed to you and are available on the USG Website Dealer Login Page. Please contact the office if you need a password.
